# Interviewing Skills

Interview is typically  
final gateway/step in  
acquiring a job

# Before the Interview

- **Research about the role (you're applying for), the Company (to understand their vision, values and what they are looking for) in a candidate.**
  - You can find these details on the internet, company websites, via linkedin connections.

# Before the Interview

- **Practice answers to mock interview questions like “why should we hire you?”**
  - You can write an outline, answering this question, review, rewrite and get used to your written choice of words.

# Before the Interview

- **Practice answers to behavioural interview questions like “Tell us more about yourself. Give us an example of how you’ve managed conflict in the past”.**
  - A good framework is the STAR Method

# STAR Method

**Situation:** Describe the context or background of the situation you are discussing. (2-3 sentences)

**Task:** Explain the specific task or challenge that you were faced with. (1-2 sentences)

**Action:** Detail the steps you took to address the task or challenge. (2-3 sentences)

**Result:** Describe the outcome or result of your actions, including any successes or accomplishments. (2-3 sentences)

# Before the Interview

- **Practice answers to Leadership Questions “Tell us about your ....”**
  - A good framework is the STAR Method



# Before the Interview

- **Practice answers to your WHY.**
  - Outline them

# Interview Day

- Dress Professionally even if its virtual.
- Arrive to the interview on time.
- Have some dry run test.
- Introduce yourself and keep up a smile

# Interview Day

- Stay present during the interview and do not multi-task.
- Avoid distraction in your background.
- Listen attentively to your interviewers.

# Interview Day

- Keep up with 2 or more questions to ask your interviewer at the end of your interview.
- Treat everyone involved in the process with respect.

# Within 24 hours after

- Send a thank you mail or note to the interviewer to express gratitude and reiterate your interest in the job.
